Spurs: may not be worn by a Pony Club member at a Pony Club activity or event unless that member has passed either the Pony Club C+ Riding Test or the Pony Club Spurs Test.

Sharp spurs are not permitted. Only blunt spurs, without rowels or sharp edges, and spurs that have a smooth rotating ball on the shank may be worn. If the spurs are curved, the curve must be downwards, and the shank must point straight to the back. The Pony Club recommends a spurs length of no greater than 2.5cm - the measurement is taken from the back of the boot to the end of the shank. No spurs with a length greater than 4cm are permitted.

Spurs must never be used to vent a competitor's anger or to reprimand the horse.

Use of the spurs which causes injury e.g. blood, broken skin or a weal, is always classed as misuse.

Misuse of the spurs anywhere at the event will result in disqualification.

Disclaimer or Liability

Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of the event to which these rules apply, nor the agent, employee or representative of these bodies accept liabilities for any accident, loss, or illness to horse, owners, riders, spectators, land or any other person or property whatsoever.

Health and Safety

The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Officials and Stewards.

About the Barrier Animal Health Show Jumping Spring Festival

The Barrier Animal Health Show Jumping Spring Festival runs alongside Dressage and Arena Eventing. Riders will compete to qualify for the Spring Festival Championships. It will be one of the main sporting events in the Pony Club calendar. Qualifying rounds for the 2027 Spring Festival Area Competitions will be starting from April 2026.

SADDLERY & DRESS

At Preliminary Round Competitions The Pony Club Saddlery and Dress rules apply.

Qualifying Stages

1. **Preliminary Rounds** for Dressage, Show Jumping and Arena Eventing are held between April 2026 and March 2027 to enable competitors to qualify for their Area Competition.

2. Those who were successful will go forward to the **Spring Festival Championship Finals** in April 2027.

Eligibility Rules:

PC70 – Riders must be aged 13 and under on 1st January 2026. A combination of horse/pony and rider are NOT eligible if they have:

- Completed at PC90 or above at any Spring Festival Championship for Show Jumping or Arena Eventing.
- Previously completed a BS/SJI Competition with a starting height of 90cm or above.
- Previously ever finished 1st to 3rd as an individual in the PC70 Show Jumping or PC70 Arena Eventing Spring Festival Championships on two occasions.

PC80 – A combination of horse/pony and rider are NOT eligible if they have:

- Completed at PC100 level or above in any Spring Festival Show Jumping or Arena Eventing Championship in 2025 or prior years.
- Previously ever finished 1st to 3rd as an individual in the PC80 Show Jumping or PC80 Arena Eventing Spring Festival Championships on two occasions.
- Previously completed a BS/SJI Competition with a starting height of 100cm or above.

PC90 – A combination of horse/pony and rider are NOT eligible if they have:

- Completed at PC110 level or above in any Spring Festival Show Jumping or Arena Eventing Championship in 2025 or prior years.

PC100 – Open to all members of The Pony Club.

Numbers to Qualify

1 – 3 starters in a class then top placed combination will qualify

4 – 6 starters in a class then top 2 will qualify

7 – 9 starters in a class then top 3 will qualify

10 – 13 starters in a class then top 4 will qualify

14 or more then top 5 will qualify

If a combination has already gained a Qualifying place, the next eligible combination on that day will be awarded the Qualifier place.

Qualifiers must have jumped a clear round in the first round or first phase if run under single or two phase.

About the Turriff Show Junior Showjumping Qualifier

For ponies 148cms and under, with riders aged 16 and under on the day of the final (1st August 2027)

Combinations must jump clear in first round/phase to qualify, disregarding those already qualified. Although unaffiliated, the qualifier is judged in accordance with Table Single Phase, British Showjumping rules, height of jumps 90cm.
